Sudipta Sarangi's work spans network theory, experimental and behavioral economics, and development economics. His research offers insights into the strategic dimensions of human behavior and the role of culture, institutions and behavioral factors. He currently serves as professor and Head of the Department of Economics at Virginia Tech. Previously, he has been a Distinguished Professor of Business Administration at Louisiana State University and Program Director at the National Science Foundation. In 2023–24, he was a Fellow of the Collégium de Lyon, a part of the French Institutes for Advanced Study. He has served as a consultant to major international organizations including the World Bank and the Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO). Currently, he serves on the editorial boards of leading journals such as the Journal of Economic Behavior and Organization, Journal of Public Economic Theory, Oxford Open Economics, and Economic Modelling. His book, *The Economics of Small Things*, showcases his talent for making complex economic ideas accessible and engaging through everyday examples. His work reflects a rare combination of cross-disciplinary insight and disciplinary rigor, making complex economic phenomena both understandable and relatable.
